## Scrappy Square in a Triangle (2016 wSeg Round Robin)

## Materials... 5 " Squares Assorted, $31 / 2$ " strips neutral, $51 / 2$ " strips main color <br> Directions

1) Cut $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips into $31 / 2 \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ Rectangles (neutral background) and sew one to each of the opposite sides of the 5 " squares. Cut in half, both directions making 4@ $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2 \prime$

2) Sew any 2 of these rectangles together in alternate directions. (Making a $41 / 2 \times 51 / 2$ rectangle, the prints do not touch in the middle.)

3) With a marking pencil, draw the diagonal of a $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " square from each Background corner. Draw on the back of this piece. (45' angle from one corner, not corner to corner, then opposite corner.)

4) Cut $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips into $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " blocks. Place a $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ by $41 / 2$ " main color rectangle under the marked piece, with right sides together. Stitch on the line and cut between the stitching lines. This will press open to be $41 / 2{ }^{\prime}$ square and you will have made 2 of them.


For Diagonal Rows alternate the blocks
