Highlighted strips below refer to the pieces needed to make the Raven/Manatee border strips that are on the sides, top and bottom sewn next to the center panel section.

The 2nd pg shows the construction process of the DM borders. The Raven/Manatee border strips are attached to each unit before sewing to the center section. Sew the sides on first. Sew the top and bottom DM borders as shown. You will need to make the 4 large corner squares and sew them to the completed top and bottom DM borders before sewing to the top and bottom of your center section.

On pages 3 & 4 I have made corrections to the instructions along with additional instructions.

I designed this pattern in Electric Quilt version 8. All measurements come directly from that program. I tried to be as accurate as possible which is why I chose to use templates for the DM borders rather than standard cutting procedures as I felt it would produce more accurate pieces.

With Selvage edges together, from 885 494 Raven cut Strips LOF, then sub-cut according to individual section

Cut 1 strip 2" x LOF for Outer Side Double Borders.							
Cut 1 strip 2½" x LOF for Inner Side Double Borders.							
Cut 1 strip 2" x LOF for Outer Top & Bottom Double Borders.							
Cut 1 strip 2 1/2" x LOF for Inner Top & Bottom Double Borders.


From 2 1/2 yds. 45" wide fabric. Cut Strips LOF: (90")

From 1895 320 Manatee cut Strips WOF, then sub-cut according to individual section instructions

Selvage edges

From ¾ yd. 45" wide fabric. Cut Strips WOF

If your fabric is under 45" wide, you will need to cut an extra 2" x WOF strip from the Manatee In order to make the strips long enough for the side borders. I show an extra strip in the cutting chart shown.



Each border consists of 1 Delectable
Mountain Long Middle Border sewn
between 2 Delectable Mountain Long Side
Borders with the Manatee and Raven strips
attached to make a complete border. The
border shown is the left side. Just flip it to
attach to the right side of the center section.

Delectable Mountain Long Side Border Strips



This is the top DM (Delectable Mountain) Border. It consists of the DM Border AND the raven & Manatee strips attached to make up this section of the border.



This is the Bottom DM (Delectable Mountain)
Border. It consists of the DM Border AND the
raven & Manatee strips attached to make up this
section of the border.



The lager corners squares get sewn to each end of a border section as shown which makes up the completed top and bottom DM border. Make 2. This is the top border. Flip it and sew to the bottom of the center section for the bottom border.


Delectable Mountain Long Side Borders: Cut each template along the dotted lines. Making sure your fabric strips are wrong sides together, place the templates on the specified fabric matching the width of the template to the width of the strip. Use a rotary cutter and small ruler to cut along the edge of the templates. Each template will produce a right side cut and a reversed cut. It is easier to keep track of the pieces by using masking tape to label each piece as shown in the chart below. For example: Template "A" will produces two pieces; an "A" piece and an "A" reversed or "A-r" piece.

From the (2) 4 ½" x LOF **1895 537 Blacklight**: Use the provided templates to sub-cut a total of:

- (4) Templates F & F-r
- (4)Templates E & E-r
- (4)Templates D & D-r

From the (2) 4 ½" x WOF **1895 39 Rust**: Use the provided templates to sub-cut a total of:

- (4) Templates C & C-r
- (4)Templates B & B-r
- (4)Template A & A-r






Figure 3-Left Side

Following the Figure 3 Left diagram, sew:

- (1) Blacklight F piece to (1) Rust C-r piece.
- (1) Blacklight E piece to (1) Rust B-r piece.
- (1) Blacklight D piece to (1) Rust A-r piece.
- (1) Blacklight D-r piece to (1) Rust A piece.
- (1) Blacklight E-r piece to (1) Rust B piece.
- (1) Blacklight F-r piece to (1) Rust C piece.

Following the Figure 3-a Right Side diagram, sew:

- (1) Rust C piece to (1) Blacklight F-r piece.
- (1) Rust B piece to (1) Blacklight E-r piece.
- (1) Rust A piece to (1) Blacklight D-r piece.
- (1) Rust A-r piece to (1) Blacklight D piece.
- (1) Rust B-r piece to (1) Blacklight E piece.
- (1) Rust C-r piece to (1) Blacklight F piece.

Press seams open then join each section together as shown in the diagrams. Make 2 Right Sides and 2 Left Sides.

Delectable Mountain Middle Side Borders

From the (1) 3 1/8" x 17 ½" 1895 537 Blacklight: Use the provided templates to sub-cut a total of:

- (2) Templates F & F-r
- (2)Templates E & E-r
- (2)Templates D & D-r

From the (1) 3 1/8" x 17 ½" **1895 39 Rust**: Use the provided templates to sub-cut a total of:

- (2) Templates C & C-r
- (2)Templates B & B-r
- (2)Template A & A-r

Sew the middle section side borders exactly as you did for the Long Side Borders. Following Figure 3 and Figure 3-a above for placement of pieces and color placement. Press seams open. Make 2 units.

Sew a DM Middle Side Section between the 2 Left Side Delectable Mountain Borders and the 2 Right side Delectable Mountain Borders.

Each Border strip should measure 64 1/2" long.

Delectable Mountain Long Side Borders

- From the (4) 1895 320 Manatee strips: Sew two 2" x WOF strips together on short ends and trim to 2" x 64 ½" Make 2. (If your fabric is less than 45 inches wide, you may need to cut an additional 2" strip to get the correct length)
- From the 885 494 Raven strips: (2) 3 1/2" x 64 1/2"

Sew a 2" x 64 ½" 1895 320 Manatee strip to a 3 ½" x 64 ½" 885 494 Raven strip. Press to the dark. Make 2.

Sew a Raven/Manatee Long Side Border to the completed Left and Right Side Border units making sure that the Manatee is sewn next to the rust color of the DM border. Make 2

Sew the completed side borders to the left and right sides of the Bison center section. Press seams to the borders.

Delectable Mountain Top and Bottom Borders

From the (1) 7 ½" x LOF **1895 537 Blacklight**: Use the provided templates to sub-cut a total of:

- (2) Templates F & F-r
- (2)Templates E & E-r
- (2)Templates D & D-r

From the (1) 2 1/8" x WOF" 1895 39 Rust: Use the provided templates to sub-cut a total of:

- (2) Templates C & C-r
- (2)Templates B & B-r
- (2)Template A & A-r
- From the 1895 320 Manatee strips: (2) 2" x WOF strips
- From the 885 494 Raven strips: (2) 3 ½" x WOF
- Sew a 2" x WOF Manatee strip to a 3 ½" x WOF Raven strip along the long sides. Trim sewn unit to 42 ½". Make 2




Figure 4 - Top Delectable Mountain Border




Figure 5 - Bottom Delectable Mountain Border

Sew the Top and Bottom Delectable Mountain Borders as you did for the Long Side Borders. Follow Figure 4 and Figure 5 below for placement of pieces and color placement. Press seams open. Make (1) of each border.

Sew a Raven/Manatee strip to the completed Top and Bottom Border unit making sure that the Manatee is sewn next to the rust color of the DM border. Make 2 units as shown below.
