December 2018

Using my book Cuppa, we will create your choice of 9" blocks. Starting with a fun textural background to display your latte, cappuccino and Americano filled coffee cups. These will be cut from hand dyed wools and cotton fabrics. You will then give each cup personality embellishing with textural threads and stitches. You can continue on to make more blocks for the quilt or incorporate the blocks on a pillow or bag.

Supply List

Notions Freezer paper, pencil and paper scissors

10 or 11 Straw needles for cotton appliqué and beading

24 Chenille needle for wool appliqué and embroidery

18 Chenille needle for couching

#3 and #1 Milliners needles for wrapped stitches

Efina 60/2 cotton thread and 50/50 Ellana wool thread for appliqué

Thread Heaven

Clover appliqué pins

Fabric scissors

Small cutting mat, ruler and rotary cutter

Background and Appliqué

9-1/2" square beige hand dyed wool for each background

A small assortment of beige cotton fabrics and beige ribbons for layering your background these should match the color of your wool

Twenty 6" squares of hand dyed wool in fun colors for cups

Scraps of cotton and velvet fabrics

¼ yard Presto Sheer for stabilizing silk velvet

Embellishments

A solid and a variegated beige #8 and #5 Eleganza Perle cotton to embellish background

A wide assorted of different colors of perle cottons size #8 and larger, different fibers, yarns and beads for embellishing cups.
