

SUNDIAL QUILT

PRE-CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

The following items are required for this class:

- The Sundial quilt pattern & papers (REMINDER: Make sure to check the Quiltworx website for any corrections or updates to this pattern)
- Fabric required per the pattern (*This pattern is available in Quiltster to design your own colorway or you can have Jenny help you design your quilt in Quiltster for a small fee*)
- 7 – Gallon size or larger Ziploc Bags
- It is highly recommended to use the 18" add-a-quarter ruler for this pattern
- Other supplies as listed on Quiltworx Class Supply List handout
- Please watch the YouTube videos listed on the class supply sheet

Selecting and purchasing your fabrics and pattern is a mandatory requirement prior to taking this course. It is recommended that you begin preparing at least 2 to 3-WEEKS prior to the class to make sure that you become familiar with your pattern and to complete any fabric pre-class cutting that may be required beforehand. If this step is not completed, you will have a very difficult time keeping up and participating in the instruction. Please read through and become familiar with your pattern. I will start the class with showing how to use the templates and template layout sheets to sub cut the fabric strips that you have already cut and placed in the appropriate bags. **If for any reason you are not sure or have questions on what, how, or why to cut the papers or the fabrics, please do not cut them until you confirm with me at class or feel free to contact the quilt shop with any questions prior to class.** If you can get this pre-cutting completed prior to class, we can start sewing much sooner and make better progress in completing the units for this quilt.



PRE-CLASS CUTTING & ORGANIZATION

There are cutting instructions for each section in your pattern listed under “Cutting Instructions” I have indicated the page numbers from the pattern so you can follow along and check each one off as you go:

Label your (7) Ziploc bags: Bag A-A, Bag A-B, Bag A-C, Bag A-D, Bag B1, Bag B2, Bag B3

Cutting instructions for the papers: These are the papers that you will have in your pattern: (1) page of NP 698, (1) page of NP 699, (1) page of NP 700, (1) page of NP 705, (1) page of NP 706, (1) page of TP 515, (1) page of TP 516, (1) page of LP 40

Please watch the YouTube videos listed on the class hand out sheet on cutting out your papers for tips and shortcuts on cutting out your papers. I will also cover these cutting instructions in class, but it's helpful if you review all instructions and the pattern prior to class.

When you cut all your papers out, you will need to cut them about 1/8” to 1/4” away from or outside dark outline. **Do not sub-cut** the template layout sheets apart on any of the cut lines. These will be used to cut out your fabrics into the correct sizes needed for piecing.

Please cut the following papers and place into the following bags:

- From NP 698, NP 699, NP 700, NP 705, NP 706 cut out the foundation papers and place them in the indicated bags as listed below and you can follow along in your pattern on page 5. Remember to cut about 1/8” to 1/4” outside the edge of the unit.
- NP 698: Foundation Layout Sheet 4, Color Group A – place in Bag A-A, Color Group C – place in Bag A-C
- NP 699: Foundation Layout Sheet 3, Color Group D – place in Bag A-D, Color Group B – place in Bag A-B
- NP 700: Foundation Layout Sheet 1, Color Group D – place in Bag A-D, Color Group B – place in Bag A-B
- NP 705: Foundation Layout Sheet 2, Color Group A – place in Bag A-A, TLS #1 & TLS #2, place in Bag A-A
- NP 706: Foundation Layout Sheet 2, Color Group C – place in Bag A-C, TLS #1 & TLS #2, place in Bag A-A

- From NP 704, TP 516, TP 516 cut out the foundation papers and place them in the indicated bags as listed below and you can follow along in your pattern on page 13. Remember to cut about 1/8” to 1/4” outside the edge of the unit.
 - NP 704: cut (12) Unit B1 and place in Bag B1, cut (12) Unit B2 and place in Bag B2
 - TP 515: cut out each T-Template B1L, B2, B3, B4 and place in Bag B3
 - TP 516: cut out each T-Template B1R, B5, B6, B7 and place in Bag B3

Cutting instructions for the fabrics:

- For Group A
 - Strip Set: Reference your pattern pages 5 – 7 If you are using the pre-packaged strip set that Quiltworx has put together see instructions for Option 1 starting on page 5. Then continue on to Page 6 sorting as instructed. If you are going to use your own fabrics, see Option 2 starting on page 7. You will need a total of (48) 2 1/2” strips in a range of four color families from light, medium light, medium dark, and dark. Once you have your strips organized in color groups, clip them together in the groups of 10 strips and place in the correct color group bag.
 - For Fabrics S1:a thru S1:d – cut (2) 2 1/2” strips from each fabric and place in Bag A-A for now (we will subcut them in class)
 - For Fabrics S2:a & S2:c – cut (1) 2 1/4” strip from each fabric and place in Bag A-B for now
 - For Fabric AP1 – cut (1) 7” square and place in Bag A-A
- For Group B (Unit B1, Unit B2, and T-Templates, Bags B1- B3) see pages 12-15
 - From Fabric B1:a, B1:b, B1:c – cut (1) 10” WOF strip from each fabric, clip with T-Templates B1R & B1L, place in Bag B3
 - From Fabric B2:a – cut (2) 18” WOF strips, clip with T-Templates B2 & B3, place in Bag B3
 - From Fabric B2:b – cut (2) 10” WOF strips, clip with T-Templates B4 & B5, place in Bag B3
 - From Fabric B2:c – cut (2) 18” WOF strips, clip with T-Templates B6 & B7, place in Bag B3
 - From Fabrics B3:a – B3:h you should have (8) 2 1/2’ strips either from a color group from the pre-packaged strip set or your own fabrics. They should be in order from lightest to the darkest and B3:a being the lightest strip and B3:h the darkest strip (see page 15). Divide the strips into 2 groups: B3:a, B3:c, B3:e, B3:g and place in Bag B1 with Unit 1, and then group, B3:b, B3:d, B3:f, B3:h and place in Bag B2 with Unit 2
