PRE-CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

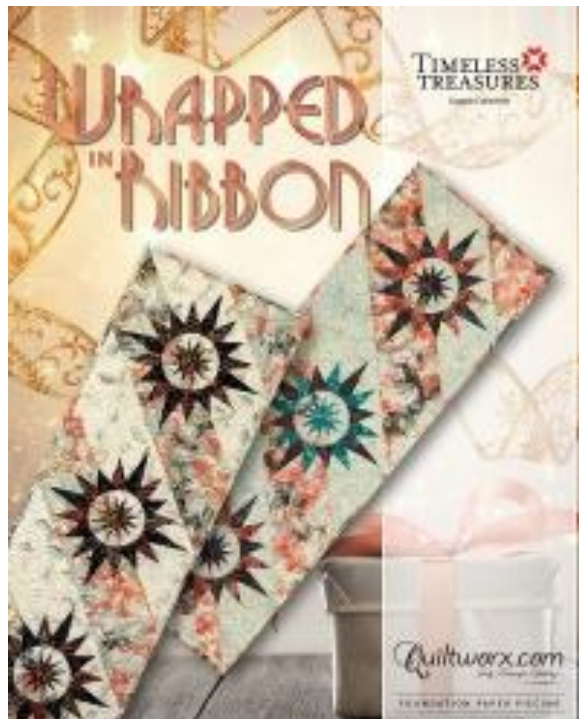

The following items are required for this class:

- The Wrapped in Ribbon Table Runner pattern & papers (REMINDER: Make sure to check the Quiltworx website for any corrections or updates to this pattern)
- Fabric required per the pattern (this pattern comes with enough papers to make 2 table runners) *This pattern is available in Quiltster to design your own colorway or you can have Jenny help you design your quilt in Quiltster for a small fee*
- 3 – Gallon size or larger Ziploc Bags
- Other supplies as listed on Quiltworx Class Supply List handout
- Please watch the YouTube videos listed on the class supply sheet

Selecting and purchasing your fabrics and pattern is a mandatory requirement prior to taking this course. It is recommended that you begin preparing at least 2 to 3-WEEKS prior to the class to make sure that you become familiar with your pattern and to complete any fabric pre-class cutting that may be required beforehand. If this step is not completed, you will have a very difficult time keeping up and participating in the instruction. Please read through and become familiar with your pattern. I will start the class with showing how to use the templates and template layout sheets to sub cut the fabric strips that you have already cut and placed in the appropriate bags. **If for any reason you are not sure or have questions on what, how, or why to cut the papers or the fabrics, please do not cut them until you confirm with me at class or feel free to contact the quilt shop with any questions prior to class.** If you can get this pre-cutting completed prior to class, we can start sewing much sooner and make better progress in completing the units for this quilt.



PRE-CLASS CUTTING & ORGANIZATION

There are cutting instructions for each section in your pattern listed under “Cutting Instructions” I have indicated the page numbers from the pattern so you can follow along and check each one off as you go:

Label your (3) Ziploc bags: Bag #1, Bag #2, Bag #3 (borders)

Cutting instructions for the papers: These are the papers that you will have in your pattern: (2) pages of NP 432, (2) pages of TP 253 (the page title and number will be along the bottom edge of the paper).

Please watch the YouTube videos listed on the class hand out sheet on cutting out your papers for tips and shortcuts on cutting out your papers. I will also cover these cutting instructions in class, but it's helpful if you review all instructions and the pattern prior to class.

When you cut out your papers, you need to become familiar with the difference between your **foundation papers** (the Unit papers that you will be sewing your fabrics to) and the **templates** (the papers that you use to cut out your fabrics into the right sizes to sew onto the units). When you cut all your papers out, you will need to cut them about 1/8” to 1/4” away from or outside dark outline. **Do not sub-cut** the template layout sheets apart on any of the cut lines. These will be used to cut out your fabrics into the correct sizes needed for piecing.

Please cut the following papers and place into the following bags:

- Cut out (12) each of Unit A1 and Unit A2, and place the Unit A1 into Bag #1 and Unit A2 into Bag #2. These will be out of your NP 432 papers. Remember you have enough papers to make 2 runners, so save the other papers for another project. Remember to cut about 1/8” to 1/4” outside the edge of the unit. Cut out the Template Layout Sheets from TP 253 and place in Bags #1 and #2 as indicated on page 4 in your pattern. The T-Templates B1 and B2 will go into Bag #3

Cutting instructions for the fabrics:

- For Group A. (Units A1 & A2, Bag #1 & #2) see pages 5-6
 - From each background Fabric A1:a & A1:b cut (1) 4 1/4” WOF strip, place in Bag #1
 - From each spike accent Fabric A2:a & A2:b, cut (1) 3 1/2” WOF strip, place in Bag #1
 - From each background Fabric A3:a & A3:b, cut (1) 8 3/4” WOF strip, place in Bag #2
 - From spike accent Fabric A4, cut (1) 7 3/4” WOF strip, place in Bag #2
 - From each spike accent A5:a & A5:b, cut (1) 5 3/4” WOF strip, place in Bag #2
 - From spike accent Fabric A6, cut (1) 6 3/4” WOF strip, place in Bag #2
- For Group B (T-Templates B1 & B2 Border) see page 9
 - From each background Fabric B1:a & B1:b, cut (1) 6 1/2” WOF strip, place in Bag #3
