



Art Quilt II Finishing

Skill Level: Intermediate

Do you have an Art Quilt you would like to finish? Decide on which stitches work well for quilting your art piece, free motion, zig zag, specialty stitches, walking foot, etc. We will be quilting and finishing samples in class with facing, pillowcase, zigzag edge and piping techniques. There will be a canvas wrapping demo. Learn how to square and block your quilt before finishing. Feel free to bring a small quilt for suggestions during class.

Class Supplies

- Capture Your Own Life with Collage Quilting Book
- 4 sets of Quilt Sandwiches- backing, cotton batting and top – approx. 10"x10" square – preferably light colors or muslin to add notes directly on the fabric
- 1 strip of fabric- 2" x Width of Fabric – to face one of the quilt sandwiches
- Thread to quilt and sew with – bring your favorites! Embroidery thread works well for free motion quilting. Extra Bobbins
- Sewing machine, manual, foot control, cord and accessories, ¼" foot with guide
- Optional: Free Motion Foot (w/quilting gloves), Walking Foot, Foot for Specialty stitches
- Paper and Pencil to practice free motion designs
- Self Threading needles
- Blue Marking Pen
- Ultra Fine Tip Black Sharpie
- Rotary Cutter & Mat, 12 ½" x 12 ½" acrylic ruler
