

Artful Log Cabin Class Instructor: Tawny Morrison

Skill Level Intermediate

Unleash your creativity by using the methods in the Artful Log Cabin book to make an art quilt from a favorite image or photo. To make your art quilt, you will select fabrics that represent the colors in your image, use a grid system to transfer your image for the project and sew log cabin blocks to make your art quilt. Instructions for quilting and facing the quilt will also be given in class. This is a 6-hour class and it is divided into 2 sessions. The first session is 2 hours and the second session is 4 hours. Finished size of the quilt is approximately $27^{\prime\prime}W \times 22^{\prime\prime}L$.

Class Supplies

- Artful Log Cabin Book
- Photo or image (landscape, floral, inspiration) Must be approved by instructor before first class.
- 6"x24" or 6 ½"x24 1/2" acrylic ruler
- 2 ½" x 12 ½" acrylic Ruler
- Seam Roller or Clover Finger Press
- Add-A-Eighth Ruler (10.75")
- Add-A-Quarter Ruler (12") or 2 ½ "x 12" acrylic ruler (Creative Grids brand highly recommended)
- Fabric pieces from your stash that work with the colors in your picture. (Note: do not purchase any additional fabric before first class or cut anything before the first class)
- Sewing Machine & basic supplies, neutral thread-50 weight, pins etc.
- A rotary cutter (60mm recommended) and a small cutting mat is needed, approx. 12"x18". A small iron and ironing surface is helpful. Also, you will need several old pins for pinning fabric to the foam core.
- I use Magic Pins or Flower Head Pins for sewing the blocks.



Additional Supplies (These supplies can be found at office supply stores, dollar stores and big box stores.)

- Fine Point Black Sharpie Marker
- Manilla Folder
- 4 Large Paper Clips
- Post It Notes
- Pen
- 2 pieces foam core
- Packing tape
- Scotch Tape
- Mechanical Pencil

Preparation Prior to Class

First Session

• Approved photo must be enlarged to 8"x 10" per instructions from the instructor. Selects fabrics scraps from your stash that work with the colors in your picture. (Note: do not purchase any additional fabric before first class or cut anything before the first class)

Second Session

• Preparation instructions for the second class will be given at the end of the first class.
