Brightly Brightly is beginner friendly quilt that goes together quickly. It has two blocks that sew up into a wonderful design. It is perfect to make with a layer cake, fat quarters, or scraps. You can make the entire quilt with just one layer cake (40 10" squares) plus a background fabric.

Note: If your layer cake has fabric that matches your background too closely you may want to purchase either an additional Charm pack or a couple of Fat Quarters to supplement it.

Supply List

- ☐ Pattern: Brightly by Cluck Cluck Sew
- ☐ Sewing machine in good working order
- ☐ Power cord and foot pedal
- ☐ Machine needles
- ☐ Thread
- ☐ Scissors
- ☐ Rotary cutter
- ☐ 6" by 12" ruler
- ☐ Optional but particularly useful Creative grids small, folded corner clipper or Diagonal Seam Tape (I will demonstrate the use of both)

To Do Before Class

Following the cutting instructions in the pattern, please cut your focus fabric from either your layer cake or fat quarters. Also remember to cut your background pieces as well.

Note: As you cut, please check that you are cutting accurately. Even if using a die cutter, pieces can be slightly off.
