



Beginner Quilting Class - Supply List

Class Supplies

- Cascade Pattern by Villa Rosa Designs
- Sewing machine in good working condition, owners manual, power cord, foot pedal
- 1/4" foot for your machine
- Extra needles and bobbins for your machine
- Neutral thread and pre-wound bobbins
- Scissors
- Pins
- 6&1/2" X 24" acrylic ruler
- Rotary cutter with sharp blade
- Cutting mat
- Marking pen/pencil
- I prefer to use Best Press starch alternative in all my piecing.(available in shop)

Fabric requirements

Please see the pattern for more details. Generally, you can use a charm pack of 5" pre-cut squares, or 35 5" squares cut from yardage. If you choose yardage you will need 3/4 yard for the squares.

There are irons and ironing boards available but feel free to bring your own if you prefer.

Preparation Prior to Class

Simply have your fabrics purchased, as described above and bring the supplies listed. This is truly a learn to quilt class, from beginning to the end! We will go over fabric selection in our first class, and begin cutting for the blocks and start assembly. Second class will be completing the block assembly and beginning to lay out blocks. We will then take a picture of the layout and make any changes before constructing the quilt top. Third class will be completing top and marking for quilting. We will then make the quilt sandwich and pin/spray baste. Quilting will be the next step. Last class will be completing the quilting, trimming and binding.
