



## **Crazy Love & Hearts Reversible Table Runner**

Class Skill Level: Intermediate

Make a fun reversible table runner to add some sparkle to your table décor! Add Love for Valentine's Day and Hearts for St Patrick's Day or this would be perfect for a bridal shower or wedding signature table runner. Use colors to match your décor, the season, or coordinate with the wedding party!

### **Class Supplies**

- Crazy Love and Crazy Hearts Patterns by Cut Loose Press
- Creative Grid Spider Web Ruler, CGRKA6
- 6 1/2" x 24 1/2" Acrylic Ruler
- 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" Acrylic Ruler (optional)
- Large Square Acrylic ruler 18"- 20" (optional)
- 12"-14" foam design boards (only if you already have them)
- Cutting Mat (at least 12"x18") with rotary cutter
- Sewing Machine in good working order, power cord, foot control, 1/4" foot
- Scissors, Pins for sewing and to pin labels on each section, extra machine needles, seam ripper, etc., Purple air erase marking pen, basic quilting supplies
- Thread to match fabric and pre-wound bobbins

### **Fabric Requirements for Reversible Table Runner**

#### **Love Side**

- 4 fat quarters for letters
- 4 fat quarters (light value) for background or 1 yard for one color background
- Note that leftover letter color pieces will be used for sashing

#### **Hearts side**

- 6 coordinating fat quarters
- 5/8 Yard light value print for background
- 1/3 yard fabric for binding (should coordinate with both sides)

If you choose to only make one side; follow the fabric supply list included with pattern!

### **Preparation Prior to Class**

Check for directional fabrics BEFORE CUTTING! Label ALL the cut pieces. This will help immensely in class. Please wait till class to use the Spider Web ruler.

#### **Crazy Love cutting prep**

- L: Letter L color cut (1) 3 1/2" x 16" and (1) 6" x 7" rectangle
  - Background cut (1) 8" x 17 1/2" and (1) 1 1/2" x 6" rectangle
- O: Letter O color cut (2) 3"x12" and (1) 9" x 12" rectangles
  - Background cut (1) 1 1/4" x 20" strip from one end of the fat quarter (or yardage). Sub cut into (2) 1 1/4" x 8" strips



- V: Letter V color Cut (1) 13" x 16" rectangle
  - Background cut (1) 16" square
- E: Letter E color cut (1) 3 1/4" x 12"; (1) 3" x 5" and (1) 6 1/2" x 10" rectangles
  - Background (refer to diagram on page 2) cut (1) 2" x 12"; (2) 2 1/2" x 11"; (1) 2" x 3" and (1) 6 1/2" x 10" rectangles

#### Hearts cutting prep

- Heart Colors: Cut (1) 14 1/2" square from EACH fat quarter

Background Fabric: Cut (1) 6" x Width of Fabric (WOF) strip

Cut (1) 4" x WOF strip

Cut (1) 10" x WOF strip; sub cut (1) 10" x 11 1/2" rectangle

Cut (5) 2" x 22" sashing from the remaining 10" strip

**ONLY CUT BORDERS AND BINDING IF YOU'RE NOT MAKING YOUR HEARTS REVERSIBLE!  
BRING ALL LEFTOVER FABRICS TO CLASS**
