



Diva Wallet

The Diva Wallet may look sophisticated but it's easier to make than you think! Just be careful who you show it to – they'll all want one! The key to making the wallet is organization. Use my cutting cheat sheet to label each piece as you cut.

Class Supplies

- Diva Frame Wallet pattern by Sew Many Creations
- Diva Wallet Frame (7 1/2 inch)
- Fabrics and stabilizer as stated in the pattern
- Wonder clips
- 1/4 inch foot for your machine
- Open toe foot for your machine
- Marking tool that shows up on your fabric choices
- Super sharp small scissors
- Sewing machine in good working order with foot pedal, power cords and instruction manual
- Basic sewing notions

Preparation Prior to Class

Using the attached cutting cheat sheet (go to next page), cut and label all of your pieces before you come to class.

Be sure you have the means to sew an accurate 1/4 inch seam allowance. It is the key to accurate piecing.

Diva Wallet Cutting Chart
(when using a 7½ inch wallet frame)
Stay organized - cut this sheet into labels
and label each piece as you cut them out.

Fabric 1 (Main) -Body - cut (1) 8 x 9 L Rectangle	Fabric 2 (Accent) -Body cut (1) 8 W x 9 L Rectangles
Fabric 1 (Main) -Zipper Pocket cut (2) 8 W x 4 L rectangles	Fabric 2 (Accent) -Card Pocket #1 & #3 cut (2) 8 W x 4 L Rectangles
Fabric 1 (Main) -Open Pocket cut (2) 8 W x 3 ¾ L Rectangles	Interfacing -Body – cut (2) 8 W x 9 L Rectangles
Fabric 1 (Main) -Card Pocket #2 cut (1) 8 W x 4 L Rectangles	Interfacing -Zipper Pocket cut (1) 8 W x 4 L Rectangle
	Interfacing -Open Pocket cut (1) 8 W x 3 ¾ L Rectangle
