



Fiona's Daisy Chain

Class Skill Level: VERY Confident Beginner to Intermediate (even the seasoned quilter will enjoy this)

Are you enamored with variations of Irish Chain blocks? Do you like to incorporate large scale fabrics into your quilts? If so, THIS is the quilt for you!!

Class Supplies

- Fiona's Daisy Chain Pattern by Robin Pickens. Please refer to the pattern for fabric requirements.
- 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" acrylic ruler
- 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" acrylic ruler
- 1/4" foot made for your sewing machine
- Pressing mat
- Portable Iron
- Mechanical Pencil
- Normal Sewing Supplies, including sewing machine, power cord, foot pedal, manual for sewing machine, spare needles and bobbins, neutral thread, pins, pencil, post it notes, small scissors to trim threads, seam ripper, 45 mm rotary cutter with a sharp blade, small cutting mat, iron and ironing surface (there are classroom irons and ironing stations available for use) highlighter.

Fabric Selection

Fabrics from your stash or yardage work well with this pattern. I chose a berry colored shot cotton in yardage for my background squares in the store sample. This quilt also looks good in light or dark backgrounds, Seasonal and Batiks would be beautiful too! Please consider choosing a large scale print for the featured squares. You will want to choose fabrics that have contrast between the feature blocks and background.

Preparation Prior to Class

Please review and refer to the cutting instructions on page 1 of the pattern. Check the fabric requirements and bring all your fabrics to class. It's okay to starch yardage before cutting, especially if you've chosen to use one background color. Please cut both feature and background pieces. It is very important to label each set of subcuts.

If you have a travel iron, please bring it and a portable ironing surface as you'll be doing a lot of pressing during class.

I highly recommend Best Press Spray.

Be sure you have the means to sew an accurate 1/4 inch seam allowance. It is the key to accurate piecing!



A few housekeeping items:

Please park in front of Quilt Patch only when unloading or loading your car. Please move your car to the church parking lot prior to class.

Quilt Patch Fabrics opens at 10:00 am. Please have sewing machine and sewing station set up and ready to go by 10:30 am.

All personal items (bags, purses, etc.) need to be stored under your table. This is a safety issue, especially when we have a full class.

You are welcome to bring your bagged lunch.
All drinks must be in spill proof containers.
