Hello Fabric Friends!

This quilt has a great design, looks difficult but is easy to assemble once you understand the simple techniques behind them. This would look beautiful with floral, or novelty fabric such as vegetables, bugs or insects too. A confident beginner or veteran quilter will enjoy making this quilt.

Class Supplies

	Flower Stalls pattern by Beyond the Reef (required)
	6 ½" x 24 ½" ruler
	Sewing machine, manual, cords and foot pedal
	Neutral thread (I recommend Aurafil)
	Pencil/pen
	Pins
	Sewing clips (optional)
	Rotary cutter
	Cutting mat
	Small scissors
	Best Press Spray (recommended)
\Box	Iron and ironing surface (ontional)

Fabric Selection

I recommend not using directional prints, unless you want to use them for your large squares. If you use them for smaller strips and sashing, you will need to be very mindful during cutting and placement.

Cutting Instructions Prior to Class

Please precut your fabrics before class according to the pattern. If you are uncertain, please reach out to me at sheinmm@gmail.com or text me at 704 771-9883. Please include your name and the quilt class so I can be prepared to answer your questions!

There are class irons and ironing boards that you may use, however if you prefer to use your own, feel free to bring an iron and ironing surface. I highly recommend Best Press Spray. Be sure you have the means to sew an accurate ¼ inch seam allowance. It is the key to accurate piecing.

A few housekeeping items

☐ Please park in from of Quilt Patch only when unloading or loading your car. Please move your car to the church parking lot prior to class. Please do not park to the right of the far classroom window. Those spaces are reserved for AAA Sewing and we want to be good neighbors.
 Quilt Patch Fabrics opens at 10:00 am. Please have sewing machine and sewing station set up and ready to go by 10:30 am.
