



## **Kids Learn to Quilt Summer Camp 2026**

Summer is here! Calling all confident sewists 8 years old and older! Looking to add new skills? Come and make the fun Checkmate quilt. This class is for all who know how to use their machine and want to start quilting. Checkmate is a fun pattern that introduces you to strip piecing, sub cutting strips, ¼" seam allowances, spray basting, quilting and binding.

### **Class Supplies**

- Checkmate Pattern by Fabric Café. We will be making the 40" x 58" size quilt (the quilt will be w/o sashing and borders)
- Sewing machine in good working order, with power cord, foot control & all machine feet (table for machine, if you have one), along with Instruction Manual
- ¼" foot with guide
- Walking foot for your machine
- Extra Bobbins that fit YOUR machine
- Sharp Scissors (small and large)
- Seam ripper
- Needles for your machine (size 80/12 & 90/14)
- Acrylic Ruler – 6 ½"x24 ½" & (Optional) 8 ½" square
- Straight pins
- Pin cushion
- Painters Tape
- Thread for piecing that blends with fabric and thread for quilting that blends with front and back fabrics
- Fabric marking pencil or chaco liner pen that will show on your pieced top fabrics
- 505 Temporary Spray Adhesive
- Quilting pins (straight or curved) - small amount for corners and edges of quilt
- Quilting gloves

Mark all supplies with permanent marker and/or ribbon for classes. Most supplies look the same!

### **Fabric Requirements**

- Fabric 1 – 1 yard (Cats on Sample)
- Fabric 2 – ½ yard (Allover/nondirectional fabric) (Words on Sample)
- Fabric 3 – ½ yard (Allover/nondirectional fabric) (Dots with black background on Sample)
- Binding – ½ yard

LEAVE FABRICS AND BINDING AT CUTTING TABLE W/EACH FABRIC MARKED – Will be kitted & returned in class

- Backing – 1 ¾ yard (44" wide) Allover design is good for a first quilt back
- Cotton Batting – Throw size or 46"x 64" (please don't bring polyester batting)



### **Preparation Prior to Class**

See note in all caps above, drop off fabric to be kitted at least one week before class. Mark each fabric with Name and Fabric #'s 1-3 & Binding. We will be sewing the first day and sub cutting our strips in class.

Starch and Iron Backing fabric before class, bring on a hanger.
