



Landscape Quilt Design

Capture your landscape photo in fabric and learn how to transform it into a beautiful wall hanging. This class will cover tracing your photo, creating a pattern, changing your fabric colors with tea dyeing, paints and markers and using wonder under for raw edge applique. The quilting on the sample was done with straight and zig zag stitches to finish the collage. Instructions will be given in class to quilt and finish your landscape at home.

Class Supplies

- Capture Your Own Life with Collage Quilting Book
- 8"x10" – 16"x20" landscape photo in color
- Pattern Ease – size of photo plus 2" all around
- Wonder Under – 2 yards
- White flannel or cotton batting – size of photo plus 2" all around
- Ultra Fine Tip Black Sharpie/Mechanical Pencil/Pen
- Fabrics: assorted colors (greens, beiges, browns, blues, etc) to match landscape. Batiks work exceptionally well for this. ¼ yard and Fat Quarters work well for the larger pieces/sections. It helps to look at small sections of your photo to "see" colors.
- White Muslin or Cotton – ¼ yard, washed without fabric softener, ready to paint
- Freezer Paper
- Rotary Cutter & Mat, 12 ½" x 12 ½" acrylic ruler, 12 ½" x 18" acrylic ruler
- Sharp Scissors for precise cutting, large and small – Karen Kay Buckley is a good brand
- Paper Scissors
- Painters tape & 3M Magic Tape
- Tweezers for small pieces
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Optional

- Light Box, Small Iron, Ironing Pad, Applique Sheet
