



Luna by Erica Jackman from Kitchen Table Quilting

Class Skill Level: Confident Beginner (but a seasoned quilter will enjoy making this quilt)

Are you looking to make a fun and quick quilt? Have a special occasion coming up and want to make a quilt? Are you wanting to make a quick and easy quilt for a gift? This beginner friendly quilt comes in 4 sizes. In class, you will be working with 2 1/2" strips that come from a jelly roll , fat quarters or yardage. Even scraps from your stash can be used.

Class Supplies

- Luna pattern
- Feature and background fabrics (see the pattern instructions for the quantities needed). You do not need to bring backing or binding fabrics to class.
- Sewing machine in good working condition. Please bring your manual , power cord and foot pedal and any other accessories)
- 1/4" foot made for your sewing machine
- Fine pins
- Extra machine needles and bobbins
- Snipping scissors
- Neutral thread and full bobbin(s)
- Seam ripper
- Rotary cutter and extra blade(s)
- Cutting mat (recommend 17" x 23" size)
- Pressing mat and portable iron (you will do a lot of pressing in class). Starch such as Best Press.

Fabric Selection

The focus fabric blocks are made with 2 1/2" strips. You will want to choose fabrics that have contrast between the feature blocks and background. For my class sample, I chose a light colored fabric for my background squares but a dark background would also look great. The key is contrast between the feature fabrics and the background fabric. Seasonal, juvenile prints and batiks would look great for your feature fabrics

Cutting Instructions Prior to Class

Review the cutting instructions on page 1. Cut feature and background fabrics per the instructions Be sure to check the fabric requirements for the size quilt you intend to make and bring all your fabrics to class. DO NOT starch any precut fabrics (ex. Jelly Rolls) as they will shrink a bit. It's okay to starch yardage before cutting, especially if you've chosen to use one background color. Please cut both feature and background pieces. It is very important to label each set of subcuts.

Be sure you have the means to sew an accurate 1/4 inch seam allowance. It is the key to accurate piecing.
