



Orange Blossom

Class Skill Level: Intermediate

This is a beautiful quilt that has a huge WOW impact. I have seen this in a coordinated fabric line as well as two-toned fabrics and it is stunning!! My class sample is scrappy with the background being coordinated low volume prints.

Class Supplies

- Orange Blossom Quilt- by Plum Easy Patterns
- Orange Blossom Freezer paper templates, each template can be used 4-6 times!
- Orange Blossom ruler (ideal) or an 8 x 8 ruler to square block
- ¼" foot made for your sewing machine
- Water soluble glue sticks, please bring several
- **28 mm** Rotary cutter and extra blade(s)
- Normal Sewing Supplies, including sewing machine, power cord, foot pedal, manual for sewing machine, spare needles and bobbins, neutral thread, pins, pencil, post it notes, small scissors to trim threads, seam ripper, 45 mm rotary cutter with a sharp blade, small cutting mat, iron and ironing surface (there are classroom irons and ironing stations available for use) highlighter.
- All fabric for the body of the quilt top. (Excludes backing, batting and binding)

Fabric Selection

Layer cakes or yardage work well with this pattern. I chose to use a layer cake for the store sample. This quilt looks good in fabrics with high contrast in the blocks. If this is the look you are going for, please use a high contrast background. Seasonal, juvenile prints and batiks would be beautiful too!

Preparation Prior to Class

Please review and refer to the cutting instructions on page 2 of the pattern. Check the fabric requirements for the size quilt you intend to make and bring all your fabrics to class. (excluding borders if you choose to add as well as backing and binding) If using yardage or fat quarters, cut to lengths in pattern. If using layer cakes, no prep is required. DO NOT starch any precut fabrics (ex. Layer Cakes) as they will shrink a bit. It's okay to starch yardage before cutting, especially if you've chosen to use one background color. Please complete all cutting prior to class. PLEASE DO NOT IRON on the freezer paper, we will cover that in class.

If you have a travel iron and ironing surface, please bring it as you'll be doing a lot of pressing during class.



Be sure you have the means to sew an accurate 1/4 inch seam allowance. It is the key to accurate piecing.

Housekeeping Notes: Quilt Patch Fabrics offers a 15% discount on class supplies. Additionally, you get a 15% discount on your purchases on the day of the class (some exclusions apply). Please do not wear perfumes or scented lotions the day of class as many people are sensitive to strong scents. Thank you!
