



Phoebe Quilt

Class Skill Level: Confident Beginner

Have a special occasion coming up and want to make a beautiful quilt that looks more difficult than it really is? The Phoebe Quilt is precut friendly and features a beautiful strip design reminiscent of stacked books; perfect for piecing together your favorite fabrics in a beautiful arrangement.

The quilt will be most successful with small to mid size prints or solids, Be sure to pick a background fabric that is distinct from the other colors in your quilt so that the pattern is easily visible!

Class Supplies

- The Phoebe Quilt Pattern by Erica Jackman, Kitchen Table Quilting
- ¼" foot made for your sewing machine
- Sewing Machine in good working condition (with the manual and all accessories)
- 10 ½" x 10 ½" ruler
- Fine pins
- Spare machine Needles and bobbins
- Snipping Scissors
- Neutral Thread and full bobbin(s)
- Seam ripper
- Rotary cutter and extra blade(s)
- Cutting mat, recommend 17" x 23" size
- Pressing mat
- Portable iron
- All fabric for the body of the quilt top (excludes backing, batting and binding)

Fabric Selection

We'll be working with the 2 ½" strips that you bring to class. This can be from either jelly roll strips or yardage that you cut prior to class; either work well with this pattern. I chose a light colored yardage for my background squares in the store sample. This quilt also looks good in dark backgrounds, Seasonal and juvenile prints. Batiks would be beautiful too! You will want to choose fabrics that have contrast between the feature blocks and background.



Preparation Prior to Class

Please review and refer to the cutting instructions on page 1 of the pattern prior to coming to class. Check the fabric requirements for the size quilt you intend to make and bring all your fabrics to class. DO NOT starch any precut fabrics (ex. Jelly Rolls) as they will shrink a bit. It's okay to starch yardage before cutting, especially if you've chosen to use one background color. Please cut both feature and background pieces. It is very important to label each set of subcuts.
