



Supply List for Posh Jack'O Wall Hanging

Class Skill Level: Intermediate

The Posh Jack-O Wall Hanging designed by Sew Kind of Wonderful is a tribute to the fall season. Our class will use the Posh Jack-O Fabric Kit (sold separately) featuring beautiful fabrics supplied by Free Spirit. During class, you will make the three different curved blocks used in the wall hanging using the QCR Mini Ruler. In addition, I will discuss the assembly of the wall hanging.

Class Supplies:

- Posh Jack-O Fabric Kit (Includes Pattern)
- QCR Mini Ruler Acrylic
- Ruler 24 ½" x 6 ½"
- Small cutting mat and 45mm rotary cutter with a sharp blade
- Marking tool such as a mechanical pencil and/or chalk marker
- Normal sewing supplies including sewing machine, ¼" foot, power cord, foot pedal, manual for sewing machine, 50 wt thread to match your fabrics or a neutral color, pins, small scissors to trim threads

Preparation Prior to Class:

- Identify and label the assorted fabrics as to their designation in the General Cutting Instructions i.e. pumpkin 1, 2 and 3; eyes, nose and mouth fabric; crow, stem and background etc. Note: The Background fabric and Pumpkin 3 fabric are directional and will be cut in class so that you can pay attention to the directionality.
- Subcut and label the cut fabrics EXCEPT for the Pumpkin 3 and Background fabrics. I suggest organizing these pieces in baggies or cookie trays/paper plates with their sizes so that you can locate them easily when sewing.
- Do not cut out any curved pieces using the Mini QCR.
