Radio Way is a great pattern to sharpen your $\frac{1}{4}$ inch piecing skills. Using a Jelly Roll and some yardage we'll make a beautiful quilt for your home.

Class Supplies

- Radio Way pattern – look on the back to choose the size you want to make
- Jelly Roll (42 strips x width of fabric)
- Contrasting fabric for sashing strips
- $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 24\frac{1}{2}''$ ruler
- $18'' \times 24''$ cutting mat & rotary cutter
- Sewing machine in good working order, foot pedal, power cords, and manual (just in case)
- Regular sewing supplies including thread, straight pins, scissors, seam ripper, etc.

Optional Supplies

- $12\frac{1}{2}' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ ruler
- $2\frac{1}{2}' \times 12\frac{1}{2}'$ ruler

What to Know Before Class

- The number of strips and the yardage for the sashing depends on the size quilt you decide to make. A jelly roll has 42 strips and will work for the baby and lap size. Check your pattern to determine yardage you will need for the sashing.
- All cutting will be done in class.
