



The Spellbound Hat

Class Skill Level: Intermediate

Time to get your spooktacular hat ready for the season! My sample is Halloween scrappy; but let your imagination run wild, you can make it in your favorite colors, or make one for every season! Bring to class your quilted fabric pieces and learn how to construct this super cute hat!

Class Supplies

- The Spellbound Hat pattern- by Melissa Mortenson
- Pellon Flex Foam, or Soft and Stable Foam Stabilizer 1 1/2
- Heavyweight Fusible Interfacing such as Pellon Fusible Decor Bond 809
- Fabrics - please see pattern for specifics; you will need up to 3 ½ yards of various fabrics
- ¼" foot made for your sewing machine
- Walking foot for your machine
- Normal Sewing Supplies, including sewing machine, power cord, foot pedal, manual for sewing machine, spare needles and bobbins, neutral thread, pins, pencil, post it notes, small scissors to trim threads, seam ripper, 45 mm rotary cutter with a sharp blade, small cutting mat, iron and ironing surface (there are classroom irons and ironing stations available for use) highlighter.
- Cutting mat
- Heat erasable marking pen

Fabric Selection

I made View 3, and chose to raid my Halloween scrap bins and pieced together two pieces that were then sandwiched with the stabilizer foam and lining fabric; quilted and cut to make the hat. Those two pieces/sandwiches are 20" x 20" and 18" x 24". You can use yardage from seasonal collections or fabrics all in your favorite color, charm packs, fat quarters... the sky is the limit. Note that my outer cone, outer brim, and inner brim are all pieced. The lining of the cone is a solid/whole cloth.

Preparation Prior to Class

The purpose of this class is to construct the hat together in class, using the two pieces YOU'VE ALREADY PIECED AND QUILTED. Please review the pattern, and COMPLETE sections One and Two, pages 1-5. Do not cut the quilted pieces, we will do this together in class. We will also cut the bias binding together in class.



Be sure you have the means to sew an accurate $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam allowance. It is the key to accurate piecing.
