



## **SURFACE CURVES**

**Class Skill Level:** Intermediate

Have you always wanted to make a quilt with curves and circles but it just seemed so intimidating? It is sew much easier than you think! In this class, you will learn how to use the CutRite Slit N' Sew templates to create these circular blocks. Your fabrics make the possibilities endless!

### **Supplies needed for class:**

- Surface Curves pattern by Canuck Quilter Designs.
- Fabric. Regardless of the pattern fabric requirements, we will be working with 10" squares. You can purchase a layer cake or similar product for a curated fabric selection, or you can cut up fabrics of your choice into 10" squares. Please note that you will want contrast between your fabrics so a layer cake with coordinating, but contrasting fabric will work as well.
- Drunkards Path template. CutRite Slit N' Sew Drunkard's Path template, 8" finished size. My sample also used the 4" finished size, however, you can start with just the 8" size template.
- Rotating cutting mat. I would highly recommend this tool, but you can make it without one.
- 18mm Rotary cutter.
- Stiletto
- ¼" foot made for your sewing machine – essential for accurate piecing
- Sewing Machine in good working condition (with the manual and accessories)
- fine pins
- Spare machine Needles and bobbins
- Snipping Scissors
- Neutral Thread and full bobbin(s)
- Seam ripper

**Preparation Prior to class:** if you have elected to use yardage rather than pre-cut squares, please have all your fabric cut into 10" squares prior to class.
