

Bunches of Carrots

Bunches of Carrots Pattern by I and a Designs

Supplies

1 10x 10" square of orange fabric (makes 2) 6 x 14" green tulle for each carrot scissors, needle, thread some poly-fill or other stuffing material

Cut the 10x10" sq. in half diagonally as in diagram. Then, with right side up, fold over one of the long sides to meet with the other long side. Stitch a 1/4" seam along this edge. Then cut the excess fabric off using the edge of the folded fabric as a cutting guide. See diagram.

Turn the carrot right side out and using a pointed turner get the carrot to have a smooth and pointed end. Stuff the carrot with the stuffing a little bit at a time to ensure that the skinny end gets stuffed enough. When you have stuffed the carrot almost to the top, fold the edge under about 1/2". With needle and thread, sew a gathering stitch along one long edge of the tulle. Gather it tightly and knot off.

Next, with needle and thread, sew a gathering stitch at the fold of the carrot top. Position the gathered end of the tulle into the carrot top and tighten the stitching at the fold to enclose the tulle. Stitch a few stitches through the tulle to secure it, and then tie off with a knot.
