<u>1-701 Corner Pop®</u> Stop throwing away half of those squares you used to pop off a comer and start saving your fabric by using the Comer Pop®. Before you know it, you will be popping off the comers of every unit. The Comer Pop® does just that, it helps to add a pop of color to any unit and can add a secondary pattern to your quilt.

Required tool: Comer Pop®

Required Design Sheet: Comer Pop

Basic Sewing Supplies

Sewing Machine with

power cords and manual Gust in case)

Thread

Machine needles

Snips or trimming scissors

Seam ripper

Basic Quilting Supplies

Rotary cutter with a sharp blade

Marking Pencil (Mechanical will do)

Small cutting mat

Straight edge ruler approx. 6" x 12" or so

Invisgrip (Optional)

Best Press or light starch (Optional)

Fabric Requirements:

NOTE: If you have taken previous Tucker University courses, you may already have some smaller scraps that measure at least 3 1/4" square. If this is the case, you are ready for class.

Approximately (2) strips of fabric that measure no less than 3 1/4". For best results, these strips should read as a solid and be in strong contrast to your Pre-class units as specified below.

Pre-class construction of units

(4) 4 1/2" squares of fabric

(4) 4 1/2" (cut-size) half square triangles*

Units of your choice that have a cut size of 4 1/2" or in the case of a flying goose the cut size would be 4 1/2" x 2 1/2. For example, you might elect to construct (4) 4 1/2" quarter square triangle* units, or (4) 4 1/2" V Blocks* units, or (4) 4 1/2" Comer Beam* units

*Unit that can be constructed using a Studio 180 Design tool.
