Once you learn how make Diamond Rects® units you will no longer avoid, what you thought, was a complex technique. The Diamond Rects® is seen in the Studio 180 Design pattern entitled Sea Glass as well as Sager Creek's Smooth Sailing. Don't miss the boat, jump on board now.

Required tools: Diamond Rects®

Required Design Sheet: Diamond Rects

Basic Sewing Supplies
Sewing Machine with
power cords and manual (just in case)
Thread
Machine needles
Snips or trimming scissors
Seam ripper

Basic Quilting Supplies
Rotary cutter with a sharp blade
Marking Pencil (Mechanical will do)
Small cutting mat
Straight edge ruler approx. 6" x 12" or so
Invisigrip (Optional)
Best Press or light starch (Optional)

## Fabric Requirements:

- (1) 2 1/2" WOF strip of one fabric for the diamond center
- (1) 3" WOF strip of contrasting fabric for the side triangles or background of the unit

NOTE: If possible, students should bring with them the units they have made from previous classes.
