<u>1-801 Split Rects®</u> You can toss your plastic templates aside for good because you use your Split Rects® tool instead. Learn how to make crisp, clean half rectangles or what Deb Tucker calls a Split Rects®. By using the Split Rects® tool, you do not have to worry about shaving your plastic templates any more or knowing which was a left side or a right side piece. There are 8 different size options with the Split Rects® tool. Your stars will twinkle with these strong points.

Required tools: Split Rects®

Basic Sewing Supplies

Sewing Machine with
power cords and manual (just in case)
Thread
Machine needles
Snips or trimming scissors
Seam ripper

Basic Quilting Supplies

Rotary cutter with a sharp blade
Marking Pencil (Mechanical will do)
Small cutting mat
Straight edge ruler approx. 6" x 12" or so
Invisgrip (Optional)
Best Press or light starch (Optional)

Fabric Requirements:

- (2) 5" WOF strips of one fabric
- (2) 5" WOF strips of another fabric

NOTE: If possible, students should bring with them the units they have made from previous classes.
