<u>1-601 Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star® Basic Construction</u> Volcanoes don't belong in the center of an eight-pointed star and they won't happen to you when you use the Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star'' tool. And, by the way, there will be no y-seams! Be thoroughly stunned when you learn how to make a Lemoyne Star using a strip method. You will be able to make blocks as small as 3" all the way up to 12" with the same level of accuracy.

Required Tools: Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star® Required Design Sheet: Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star

Basic Sewing Supplies

Sewing Machine with power cords and manual (just in case) Thread Machine needles Snips or trimming scissors Seam ripper

Basic Quilting Supplies

Rotary cutter with a sharp blade Marking Pencil (Mechanical will do) Small cutting mat Straight edge ruler approx. 6" x 12" or so Invisigrip (Optional) Best Press or light starch (Optional)

<u>Fabric Requirements</u>: There should be a strong contrast between your star point fabric and your background fabric

- (2) 2 1/2" strips WOF for the star points
- (2) 3 3/4" strips WOF for the background

OR

Set 1:

- (1) 2 1/2" strip WOF for the star points for one block
- (1) 3 3/4" strip WOF for the background

Set 2:

- (1) 2 1/2" strip WOF for the star points for one block
- (1) 3 3/4" strip WOF for the background
