To help ensure your success in this course, it will be important for you to be familiar with the basic construction of the Rapid Fire® Lemoyne Star. If you have not made a Lemoyne Star using the Rapid Fire® tool in a while, you may want to practice your skills prior to class.

It would be also helpful for you to have your fabrics pre-cut prior to class so that you can spend the maximum time sewing.

1-1101 Rapid Fire® Lemoyne Star Advanced I: Strip Pieced Lemoyne, Liberty Lemoyne, and Banded Lemoyne Are you hooked on the Rapid Fire® Lemoyne Startool? You can make fancy Lemoyne Stars by learning how to create three more variations. Now that you have mastered the basic construction of the Rapid Fire ® Lemoyne Star you can expand your skills with three more options: Strip Pieced Lemoyne, Liberty Lemoyne, and Banded Lemoyne.

Basic Sewing Supplies
Sewing Machine with
Power cords and manual Gust in case)
Thread
Machine needles
Snips or trimming scissors
Seam ripper

Basic Quilting Supplies
Rotary cutter with a sharp blade
Marking Pencil (Mechanical will do)
Small cutting mat
Straight edge ruler approx. 6" x 12" or so
Invisigrip (Required)
Ultra fine Sharpie Marker
Best Press or light starch (Optional)

Fabric Requirements:

In this class you will make 3 - 8" blocks and 3 quads (one quarter of a star block). It is strongly suggested for you to pre-cut your fabrics prior to class.

Strip Pieced Lemoyne. Label your strips as I have named them. If you already have Strip Pieced Lemoyne Technique Sheet, you can refer to it for specific fabric placement.

Fabric #1 (1) - 1 3/8" x 22"

Fabric #2 (1) - 1 5/8" x 22"

Fabric #3 (1) - 1 5/8" x 22"

Fabric #4 (1) - 1 3/8" x 22"

Background (8) - 3 3/4" squares
```

Liberty Lemoyne. If you already have a Liberty Lemoyne Technique Sheet, you can refer to it for specific fabric placement.

```
Fabric A - Inner Strip (1) - 1 3/8" x WaF
Fabric B - Outer Strip (1) - 1 1/16+ (just a smidge larger than 1)
Fabric C - Middle Strip (1) - 1 1/16+ (just a smidge larger than 1)
Background (2) - 3 3/4" strips WOF
```

Banded Lemoyne

```
Fabric A - Diamond Strip (1) - 1 3/4" x 22"
Fabric B - Diamond Strip (1) - 1 3/4" x 22"
Fabric C - Band of the star (4) - 1 1/4" x 22"
Background (8) - 3 3/4" squares
```
