**1-101 Tucker Trimmer 1<sup>®</sup> and Shaded Four Patch** Learn how to use a Tucker Trimmer 1<sup>®</sup> to create half square triangles, quarter square triangles, and combination units. You will also learn how to expand the use of your Tucker Trimmer 1<sup>®</sup> by creating a Shaded Four Patch unit. By using Deb Tucker's method of strip piecing the construction of a Shaded Four Patch, the quilter eliminates the need to stitch fabrics on an unsecured bias.

\*Required Technique Sheet: Shaded Four Patch

### **Basic Sewing Supplies**

Sewing Machine with  
Power cords and manual (just in case)  
Thread  
Machine Needles  
Snips or Trimming Scissors  
Seam ripper

### **Basic Quilting Supplies**

Rotary cutter with sharp blade  
Marking Pencil (mechanical will do)  
Small cutting Mat  
Straight Edge Ruler approx. 6" x 12" or so  
Invisigrip (optional)  
Best Press or light starch (optional)

### **Pre-Cutting Directions:**

Consider using your wonder fabric from your stash. I wonder what I was thinking when I bought this...since these classes are meant for practicing a technique.

**Baggie 1:** 2 – 5" squares of Fabric A  
2 – 5" squares of Fabric B

**Baggie 2:** 2 - 5 ½" squares of Fabric A  
2 - 5 ½" Squares of Fabric B  
4 – 5 ½" squares of Fabric C

**Baggie 3:** 4 – 5 ½" squares of Fabric A  
4 – 5 ½" squares of Fabric B

**Baggie 4:** 1 – 2 ¾" strip x WOF of background  
1 – 3 ¾" strip of WOF of Fabric A  
2 – 5" x 6" rectangles of Fabric B
