<b>Class Date/Time:</b>	

<u>1-401 Square Squared & Little Houses</u> The Square Squared is an all-in-one tool that gives you a window template for accurately cutting the center square, a chart printed right on the ruler for the recommended size to cut the triangles sewn to the four sides of the center square and a trim down section on the ruler that simplifies the alignment of ruler to fabric unit and allows everyone to clean up the unit to a precise measurement every time.

\*Required Tools: Squared Square®, and Quilter's Magic Wand®

\*Required Technique Sheet: Little Houses

#### **Basic Sewing Supplies**

Sewing Machine with

Power cords and manual (just in case)

Thread

Machine Needles

Invisigrip (optional)

Best Press or light starch (optional)

#### **Basic Quilting Supplies**

Rotary cutter with sharp blade Marking Pencil (mechanical will do) Small cutting Mat Snips or Trimming Scissors Seam ripper

Straight edge ruler approx. 6"x12" or so

#### **Pre-Cutting Directions:**

Fabric: Strips can be cut from fat quarters or even scraps from your stash. However, try for minimum strip lengths of 15" and then to add up to the required length from the chart. Mix & match colors – remember that we're learning techniques and you can learn using I-wonder (I wonder why I bought this) fabric.

Pre-Class Cutting Instructions WOF = width of fabric, approx. 40"

Note: Cutting instructions are for a limited number of class samples.

### Baggie 1:

Fabric A (1) 3 ½" x WOF (Min 3 ½ by 18")

Fabric B (8) 3 1/4" Squares

#### Baggie 2:

Fabric A (4) 5" Squares for Fussy Cut Fabric B (8) 3 1/4" squares

#### Baggie 3:

Fabric A (4) 4 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" Square Fabric B (4) 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" squares
