

Applique Quilt Block of the Month

Information Sheet

Items Needed to create this quilt-

3 1/2 yards Background Fabric- This is the fabric behind the flowers and is your constant throughout the quilt.

3 1/2 yards of low loft batting-Cotton or cotton poly blend works well

Fabric for Flowers- A Layer cake, or fabric from your stash at home, works well. A variety of fabric colors you like. Some yardage will be needed to cut sashing strips from for your blocks.

1/4 yard of each- Light Green Medium Green and Dark Green fabric- This will be for your leaves and stems throughout the quilt.

Thread- Regular sewing thread and a variety of embroidery thread to embellish your blocks. A madeira variety thread pack works great for this.

1 Yard Soft Fuse- We have at Pins and Needles- This is used under your applique pieces.

A Notebook (2 Inch) with plastic sleeves to keep each blocks directions in.

Sewing Kit- Scissors, seam ripper, marking pen, quilting pins, empty bobbins (2) extra machine needles.

Before Each Class-

First and fore most... relax! This will all make sense after you attend your first class or two. We are here to help you. When you sign up for class you will receive a supply sheet/directions. Look over before class. Pre-quilting your block (info on first page of directions), tracing flower pieces on soft fuse and cutting sashing strip before class will help you complete the block in class. We will show you the techniques in class. Don't worry if you do not have specific feet or other notions listed in the directions. We have them for you at class time.
