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## **Heirloom Quilt Block**

### **April: Block 4 - Shark's Teeth**

#### **Supplies:**

**Block four is sewing and embroidery.**

**The quilt is two colors- a main color and complimentary color**

Embroidery thread in gray and contrasting color

One 14" x 20" rectangle of main cotton fabric. (If you wish to frame the teeth like sample, bring a 14" square of main fabric and a yard of small trim)

White sewing thread

Glue pen or Elmers glue stick

Temporary fabric marker (make sure it does not leave a shadow line on fabric)

Lightweight tearaway stabilizer

80 Universal or Topstitch needle

Spray starch or Best Press

Small sharp scissors

#### **Required Machine Accessories (not provided with borrowed machines):**

5"x7" embroidery hoop for two hoopings or 12" for one hooping

#### **Before Class Instructions:**

Gather all materials needed for class

#### **General Supplies:**

Machine with power cord, foot pedal, and embroidery unit

Thread

Pre-wound bobbins

Empty bobbins

Regular and fabric scissors

Wonder Clips/pins

Needles

Fabric Marker

Cutting Ruler

Machine Manual

Borrowed Machines: only the machine, foot pedal, and embroidery unit (if applicable) will be supplied. You must bring everything else needed for class.
