Heirloom Quilt Block

February: Block 2 - Pintucks and Bridging

Supplies:

Block two is sewing and embroidery.

The quilt is two colors- a main and complimentary color

One 14" x 10" rectangle of neutral fabric

Two 14" x 4 1/2" rectangles of main fabric

28" x 1" contrasting fabric for spaghetti bias (I suggest using what was used in block one as contrasting fabric.

We will make this in class)

1/2" bias maker to make spaghetti bias- Available at Pins and Needles

Sewing thread to match fabric for seams

Sewing thread to match spaghetti bias

30wt thread to do the bridging (should be a contrasting color. Also need matching bobbin or use regular embroidery thread with matching bobbin. Heavier thread looks better)

2 spools of thread matching neutral fabric for pintucks

Embroidery thread for the motif, one contrasting color

Thread for entredeux stitches, can be matching or contrasting

Thread stand or second spool holder for using double needles

2/11 twin needles (check to see if they came with your machine. Can buy at Pins if unsure of what to get)

Topstitch 80/14 needles (need the topstitch to accommodate the thicker thread)

100/110 needle (if you don't have one we can use a 90 topstitch needle)

Temporary fabric marker (make sure it does not leave a shadow line on fabric)

Lightweight tearaway stabilizer

Spray starch or Best Press/equivalent

Required Machine Accessories (not provided with borrowed machines):

5"x7" embroidery hoop (will need multiple hoopings or bring at least a 12" hoop for one hooping)

1/4" quilting foot

5 or 7 groove pintuck foot

Bridging foot if available (not essential, but easier. **If you don't have a bridging foot, bring sticky water soluble stabilizer and a small seam gauge ruler to line it up)**

Before Class Instructions:

Gather all materials needed for class

FOR WHOLE SERIES:

Embroidery designs come at no extra charge. You must bring a USB.

SUGGESTED SEWING MACHINE FEET FOR ENTIRE QUILT:

-1/4" quilting foot with guide

-Edge joining foot

-5 or 7 groove pintuck foot

-Spanish hemstitching foot and/or attachment, if available (will talk about in class)

-Dual feed or walking foot

-Embroidery foot

Fabrics are approx. amounts depending on how you plan to do your blocks. **I strongly suggest you have extra of all fabrics.** Martha Pullen does her blocks out of batiste with a fabric lining. I highly recommend you use quilting cotton (100% cotton that Pins and Needles sells) unless you are striving for the dainty baby heirloom look.

We will talk about fabrics and options in the first class. It's okay to be confused. All will be worked out.

- 5yds of cotton fabric for back
- 4 ½ yds main cotton fabric
- 2 yards of coordinating fabric if doing blocks all one color with coordinating fabric in block. More if alternating block colors. Please buy extra!!!
- 1 yard contrasting fabric for block one and spaghetti strap later.
- First few blocks do not require entredeux or insertion lace. We will discuss these in class. Instructor will put together optional kits of insertion lace and entredeux for sale for those interested. Laces and entredeux are available online. We will discuss this also.

General Supplies:

Machine with power cord, foot pedal, and embroidery unit

Thread

Pre-wound bobbins

Empty bobbins

Regular and fabric scissors

Wonder Clips/pins

Needles

Fabric Marker

Cutting Ruler

Machine Manual

Borrowed Machines: only the machine, foot pedal, and embroidery unit (if applicable) will be supplied. You must bring everything else needed for class.
