## Hello Spring

### **Supplies:**

If you are doing the whole quilt, you will want a 2-inch three-ring binder with plastic sleeves to hold your instructions for each month.

Thread: regular sewing cotton or polyester thread OR

I used light grey or white Gutermann or Madeira for construction, 40wt embroidery thread for machine appliqué and optional embroidery floss for hand embroidery

Fabric and appliqué scissors

Rotary cutter

Cutting mat (optional)

Rulers: I used a 12 ½" x 2 ½" and 6 ½" x 24 ½"

Pins and clips

Needles: 90/14 or 80/12 quilting needles for sewing machine, and optional hand embroidery needles

Fabric markers, chalk, or pencils

Wonder Fuse for appliqué

If you purchase a box of Wonder Fuse, it should cover the whole quilt

No Show Mesh cutaway or light-weight SF101 to stabilize the appliqué

Optional: Iron and ironing mat, storage zip lock bags to hold your cut pieces

### **Required Machine Accessories (not provided with borrowed machines):**

Quarter-inch foot

Open-toe foot

### **Before Class Instructions:**

FOR THE FIRST CLASS:

We will review kit cutting and color choices by month, and we will cut the material for the first month.

If making the whole quilt 80 ½" x 96 ½", white or white-on-white is the main fabric and will require the most yardage, approximately 6 yards. The rest of the quilt requires less yardage.

Again, you can choose to do the whole quilt or just the blocks of your choice.

### **General Supplies:**

Machine with power cord and foot pedal

Sewing Thread

Pre-wound sewing bobbins

Empty sewing bobbins

Regular and fabric scissors

Wonder Clips/pins

Sewing Needles

Fabric Marker

Cutting Ruler

Machine Manual

Borrowed Machines: only the machine and foot pedal will be supplied. You must bring everything else needed for class.
