### July: Block 7 - Lace Shaping in the Hoop

#### Supplies:

#### **Block seven is sewing and embroidery.**

- One 14-inch square of main cotton fabric
- One 8-inch square of white cotton netting **NOTE:** cotton netting is available on line and extremely expensive. You can substitute tulle, nylon netting, or just embroider on the fabric without any of the netting. This is what I did on the sample. The choice is yours for this supply. All of the options look good.

- sewing thread, white
- 40wt embroidery thread, white

Additional embroidery threads to give yourself options

- Temporary fabric marker
- Size 90 or top stitch universal needle
- Size 75 embroidery needle
- Tacky water-soluble stabilizer

#### Required Machine Accessories (not provided with borrowed machines):

USB stick for designs  
5x 7 or larger embroidery hoop

#### Before Class Instructions:

Press fabrics and gather all materials needed for class

#### General Supplies:

Machine with power cord and embroidery unit  
Embroidery Thread  
Pre-wound embroidery bobbins  
Empty embroidery bobbins  
Regular and fabric scissors  
Small sharp scissors  
Wonder Clips/pins  
Embroidery Needles  
Fabric Marker  
Cutting Ruler  
Machine Manual

Borrowed Machines: only the machine and embroidery unit will be supplied. You must bring everything else needed for class.
