

Pins & Needles Supply List

One Block Wonder Summer 2026 (2 part class)

Intermediate Level Class - you need to have quilt piecing previously

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WARNING: This technique is addictive! You will want to make more!

Prior to Class 1:

- Bring something to write with and take notes on to class 1.

During Class 1:

- OBW is a technique, not a pattern. There are many books, tutorials, patterns that you can follow. We will discuss a lot of them in class.
- You will be given a class handout.
- We will spend a lot of time going over fabric selection, amounts needed, cutting, and construction.
- IF you already have fabric that you want to use, bring it to class 1. Not all fabrics work well for this technique.
- Class 1 is lecture/demonstration only.

Prior to Class 2:

- Decide on your fabric. Press and starch it. Be ready to start cutting it.

During Class 2:

- Begin cutting and sewing half hexagons.
- You will need the items from the list below for class 2 (but not class 1.)
- Be aware that you will not leave with a finished quilt top. You should leave with some half hexagons completed with the knowledge of what to do next.

Supply List: Many of these are optional and will be demonstrated in class 1.

- Main fabric yardage or panels (amount needed will be discussed in class 1.)
 - If you are using panels, you need 7.
 - If you are using yardage you need a minimum of 6 repeats.
- Long rectangular rotary cutting ruler 6" x 24".
- Small rectangular 6" x 12" rotary cutting ruler with 60-degree angle marking.
 - Example Omnigrid
 - OR an equilateral triangle (or 60-degree triangle) ruler
 - Whatever ruler you choose be consistent and use it for all of your cutting.
- Rotary cutter (45-degrees and 60-degree with NEW blades) and mat.
- Basting or fine stitch gun.
- Flat flower head style pins.
- Spray starch (Flatter, Best Press or Niagara.)
- Travel iron and ironing mat.
- 6" x 6" Folding Magic Mirror
- Dinner size paper plates (yes, I mean the kind you eat off of at a picnic.)
- 1/4" quilt piecing sewing machine foot (with or without guide.)
