Supplies:

Fabrics: Color A = Blocks and Border = 2 yards
Color B = Blocks = $\frac{1}{2}$ yard
Background=Blocks, setting triangles and corners = $1 \frac{1}{4}$ yards
Sashing, Inner Border and Binding = $1 \frac{1}{2}$ yards
Cornerstones = $\frac{1}{8}$ yard

Be sure there is a lot of contrast between fabrics.

Rotary Cutter with a sharp blade installed and Cutting Mat
6 x 12 ruler and or 6 x 24 ruler
Sewing Machine with user Manual
 $\frac{1}{4}$ inch foot
Bobbins (not prewounds)
40 or 50 wt. thread for piecing- gray, ivory or white
Basic sewing kit- seam ripper, pins, marking tools, scissors
6 inch Drunkards Path Template, available at Pins & Needles on the first day of class.
Small 3 ring binder to hold Student Guide

Before First Class:

Gather Supplies and Starch (using Best Press, Quilting ,craft spray, flatter or any other product to starch your fabrics before class) and Press fabrics

General Supplies:

Machine with power cord and foot pedal
Sewing Thread
Empty sewing bobbins
Regular and fabric scissors
Wonder Clips/pins
Sewing Needles
Fabric Marker
Cutting Ruler
Machine Manual
Borrowed Machines: only the machine and foot pedal will be supplied. You must bring everything else needed for class.
