Topic: Feed dogs, snowman stickers, and free motion

Supplies:

Snowman stickers
Accessory box (Beauty box) with all accessories
Embroidery thread
Sewing thread
Monofilament if you have it. Don't buy it special for this class
Multiple pieces of fabric and batting about 12" square or larger to practice free motion on
Embroidery hoop 5x7 or larger with stabilizer, tear away or cut away doesn't matter bring enough for 2-3 hoopings
Cotton fabric for hooping and for stitching on the sewing side
Needles 90/14

Required Machine Accessories (not provided with borrowed machines):

3 feet used for free motion: Single needle hole foot "C", Open toe free-motion foot, echo foot and shank adaptor (ankle) pictures of these feet pages 118 and 119 of manual.
J foot
N foot
Embroidery foot
¼" foot
Stitch regulator and quilting feet to go with stitch regulator: regulator quilting foot, open toe, and echo. Picture of these feet and regulator on page 120 of manual
The regular needle plate and the Straight stitch needle plate, in the bottom of the beauty box, has a circle instead of an oval for the needle to go through. Has a bobbin cover with no markings attached.
Digital dual feed foot and foot soles
Quilting bar to go on dual feed foot may need adapter
Foot controller

Machine with power cord, foot pedal, and embroidery unit
Thread
Pre-wound bobbins
Empty bobbins
Regular and fabric scissors
Wonder Clips/pins
Needles
Fabric Marker
