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## Serger Ruffle Quilt

### Supplies:

5 coordinating fabrics for the top and bottom of the quilt

#1: 4 strips cut 5½ x WOF

#2: 4 strips cut 5½ x WOF

#3: 4 strips cut 5½ x WOF

#4: 4 strips cut 5½ x WOF

#5: 16 strips cut 2½ x WOF (ruffle)

Batting: 8 strips cut 5½ x 45"

4 spools of sulky 12 wt or 30 wt thread to use for your wave stitch or rolled hem on your ruffles

4 spools of serger thread in white, cream, or light grey.

### Required Machine Accessories (not provided with borrowed machines):

Appropriate serger feet

### Before Class Instructions:

Have fabric cut and pressed before class.

To save time in class: Take two strips (2½ x WOF) and sew/serge the short ends together. Do this to the remaining 14 strips, pairing them up. When you are done, you will have eight strips that are 2½ x 90"

Note: You will need a serger that can do a wave stitch, rolled hem, chain stitch, and overlock stitch. If you need to borrow one for class, be sure to let us know before the class date so we can set one up for you.

### General Supplies:

Machine with power cord and foot pedal

Serger Thread

Regular and fabric scissors

Wonder Clips/pins

Serger needles and Allen wrench to change them

Fabric Marker

Tweezers

Cutting Ruler

Machine Manual

Borrowed Machines: only the machine and foot pedal will be supplied. You must bring everything else needed for class.
