A Party Ruffle Skirt Created on a Serger

Supply List:

One Jelly roll or 40- 2 ½ x 40 inches strips of fabric.

Do not choose batik fabrics.

MUST have a Ruffler foot for your serger!!!!

If not, you can borrow a machine for the class

One spool of Decorative Thread like Wooly Nylon

4 spools of serger thread to match fabric.

Do not wash Jelly Roll before class!

2 inch elastic: RJR at Pins and Needles, there are

Multiple colors. Bring the waist measurement of the person you are making the skirt for.

We can cut the elastic the day of class.

Before Class:

The skirt has 6 rows of ruffles. Determine which rows will be used in each row.

Row#1- 1 strip

Row#2- 2 strips

Row#3- 3 ½ strips

Row#4- 6 strips

Row #5- 10 strips

Row #6- 16 strips

To save time in class, serger/sew the short ends together in each row using a 4 thread overlock or straight stitch.

Please Note: Every Serger gathers differently. You may end up with extra strips left over after you complete the skirt. This is normal!! Please do not think you are doing something wrong!

Class will start and end promptly—please be set up and ready to begin class on time.



Your payment is your commitment to your class and to the instructor. Refund will be issued IF a minimum enrollment of (2) is not met. You must give a 3-day notice to transfer the fee to another class. Student must have basic knowledge of their own sewing machine, including how to operate and thread your own machine. **Please note:** Neither your instructor or Pins & Needles can be responsible for forgotten supplies and/or equipment. Please be sure to have all of your supplies properly labeled.

 - Wonder Clips/Pins
- 4 Serger Threads to match fabric
 - Seam Ripper
