Supply List:

- *Towering Trees* pattern by *Material Possessions Studios*
- 6 or 7 strips of 2.5 inches x width of fabric batting (any low loft kind) or @ 1/3 roll of the precut kind
- 2 width of fabric x 2.5 inches strips of 3 different fabrics
- 2 pieces of fabric and one piece batting 4 x 4 inches (top tier of tree)
- 2 6"x6" pieces of fabric and 1 piece of batting for tree trunk
- Jingle bells, buttons or whatever embellishments you wish to decorate tree with.
- All-purpose construction thread
- Wonder clips (about 4 or 5) and several pins
- 4 inches of heat n bond paper release tape (can also whip stitch opening if you wish...)
- Something with a point to push out turned corners
- Rotary cutter and smaller size ruler with a 6 -12 inches cutting edge
- If you have one, a spinning cutting mat is useful
- Scissors to trim fabric at corners before turning

The pattern basically calls for different length pieces 2.5 inches wide. I have made and will bring to class templates to quickly cut your strips to the appropriate lengths. We will make the larger size tree. The sample shows the easiest and fastest pattern to cut – 3 colors with two layers of each. The tree can be made reversible but will require 19 pieces cut from one fabric and 19 different colored pieces.

***This is a 2.5 hour class so it is **very important** that you cut out all the pieces in advance. We should finish sewing the tree but will not have time to sew on all the optional jingle bells.
