Fabric 2: (Center Blocks, Corner Blocks)	1 Fat Eighth
Fabric 3: (Background of Wreath Blocks)	1 Fat Quarter
Fabric 4: (Inner Border, Binding)	1 Fat Quarter
Fabric 5: (Outer Border)	1 Fat Quarter
Fabric 6: (Backing)	¾ yard

Other: Wool or Scrap Fabrics for Wreath Appliques (green)

(4) 6" x 18" Strips of Tulle (red)

(12) Buttons (red in a variety of sizes)

Lightweight Fusible Web

Batting 24" x 24"

1/4" Foot Open Toe Foot (if doing traditional applique) Heat N Stay Fusible Stabilizer Embroidery Threads to match applique fabrics **Basic Sewing Supplies Before Class: If you feel confident to cut any or all the pieces according to the Kimberbell Cuties Book, feel free to do so. Cutting beforehand will get you a bit further in class. If you need assistance with cutting your fabrics, it is okay to wait for class.
