**Project:** Re-hooping Fiesta

### **Supply List:**

- Fiesta de Talavera CD design (**it is suggested that you purchase design ahead of time and read over general instructions prior to class.**)
- Floriani perfect stick tearaway stabilizer (Sticky stabilizer is a Must!)
- Iron and pressing board and light starch or Mary Ellen Best Spray
- Curved scissors to trim applique close to tack down stitch.
- Assorted colors of embroidery thread 40 wt. And white pre-wound Bobbins.
- Pattern uses 44 different color fabrics. (4-5 yellows, 4-5 greens etc). You don't need a lot of each fabric the applique shapes are small. We will go over this first class.
- Assorted fabric for applique: I cut 2.5" strips of fabrics pressed with best spray **The first page of each block instructions has a chart with the colors they used for that block and applique shapes and cutting instructions if preferred.**
- Light or dark Background fabric , **Blocks:** Cut (9) 22" squares press with best spray and mark center lines and diagonal lines + and x. (Every 45 degrees should have a line drawn, so that would end up in the shape of an "X" and a "+" to cover each block). **Border fabric:** Cut a length of 65" from background fabric then cut into (4) 10 ½ "X 56"strips. **Corners:** Cut (1) 10 1/2"strip then cut into (4) 10 1/2" square.

### **Before Class:**

- It is suggested that you purchase design ahead of time and read over general instructions prior to class.)**

### **\*Basic Sewing Supplies**

- Embroidery Machine, power cord, embroidery arm and embroidery foot
- Embroidery thread and wound bobbins
  - USB stick, Hoops
- Fabric and thread scissors, Power Cord
  - Seam ripper and tweezers
  - Embroidery Needles 80 or 90
  - Scissors, Pins / Wonder Clips
  - Sewing / Embroidery Needles
- Fabric Marking Pens/Markers/Chalk
