Crazy Patch Template- Copy at 200%-make 36

Fabric:

Light/White Background- 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards

Variety of Blues- 1 yard

Variety of Greens- 1 yard

Variety of Golds- 1 yard

Grays and Blacks- 1 yard

For Center Mariner's Compass:

2 Blues – $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

2 Greens – $\frac{1}{4}$ yard


2 Golds – $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Backing and Batting can be purchased later. Not needed for class.

***Basic Sewing Supplies**

- Sewing Machine/Foot Petal & Power Cord
 - Thread and 2 Bobbins
 - $\frac{1}{4}$ inch foot and J presser foot
 - Fabric Scissors
 - Seam Ripper, Pins
 - "Add $\frac{1}{4}$ inch" Ruler
 - Frixion Marking pen
- Rotary Cutter with new blade and cutting mat
 - Mini Iron and pressing mat
