**IF THIS IS YOUR FIRST MONTH STARTING THE CLASS**

If you want the quilt to look scrappy, then choose fabrics and thread colors each month. If you want it to have a particular color theme, then either use a layer cake or purchase yardage of your favorite design collection. I cannot estimate how much fabric you will need, due to not knowing what size hoop you are working with. Low loft batting is recommended. Either 100% cotton or Combo poly/cotton. I recommend Quilter's Dream. The backing can be decided upon once the quilt top is completed.

**Project #1 Flip & Stitch Block.      February Block**

**Supply List:**

6 scraps of fabric to fit your hoop size  
(Working with a fat quarter bundle makes it easy)  
Batting (a low loft batting works best)  
2 thread colors for your Daisy stitches  
White Embroidery Thread  
Poly Mesh/No show Mesh stabilizer (pieces to fit your hoop)

**Basic Sewing/Embroidery Supplies:**

Embroidery Machine in working order  
Embroidery Unit  
Power Cord  
Hoops (s)  
Pre-Wound Bobbins  
USB Stick (empty)  
Embroidery Foot  
Seam Ripper  
Sharp Appliqué Scissors  
User Manual for your machine
