***Basic Sewing Supplies**

Sewing machine & power cord & accesories (zipper foot,etc)
thread snips, seam ripper, pins,fabric marker
tape measure, scissors

Supply List:

An open mind - you CAN do this!!

Pattern, I would suggest a garment using a woven fabric to start with.

Pattern ease, to copy pattern for alterations

Black marker or pencil and scissors to copy pattern onto Pattern Ease.

Fabric-you may wait to purchase fabric until you meet with the instructor on suggestions -depending on your pattern. In the first class we'll measure for size and make any pattern alterations, then copy pattern pieces onto the pattern ease.



Your payment is your commitment to your class and to the instructor. The class may be postponed or refund issued IF a minimum enrollment is not met. You must give a 3-day notice to transfer the fee to another class. Student must have basic knowledge of their own sewing machine, including how to operate and thread your own machine. **Please note:** Neither your instructor or Pins & Needles can be responsible for forgotten supplies and/or equipment.
