Project: Bench pillow sham or table runner

Supply List:

- Pattern (Gnomes for the holiday by JoAnn Hoffman)
- fabrics 1 1/8 of background fabric suggest something light in color white with snowflakes etc.
- 1 yard for pillow background
- fat quarter of red for truck
- fat eight of red for hats
- scrap of peach for noses
- scrap of black or dark gray for shoes
- scraps of black for lantern, tires,
- trees are use 3 to 4 different colors of green that blend together nicely
- striped banners 1/8 of a yard of fabric your choice of stripes
- beard fat eight of a white-on-white fabric of your choice'
- shirts 1/8 of yard light gray or your choice'
- scrap of yellow or gold for inside of lantern
- sleds and truck side dark brown or wood looking fabric 1/8 yd
- 2 yards of soft fuse
- applique scissors, pencil for tracing, threads color to match fabrics
- Teflon pressing sheet
- 1 yard of sf 101 interfacing
- open toe foot for sewing machine,
- sewing machine
- All fabric choice can be yours; you may have fabric at home to pull out of your fabric stash.

* Basic Sewing Supplies

Before Class: Trace all design on to soft fuse for it can be iron onto the right fabric, if you feel comfortable this can be done at home that is trace and iron on. You can also cut design out if you want, if you feel un comfortable this can be done in class. Please do not cut your original pattern piece out they are only to be traced off onto soft fuse. This paper needs to be able to stand on its own and let customers know what to bring to class and a little of what to expect without talking to the teacher ahead of time

Class will start and end promptly—please be set up and ready to begin class on time.
