Project: Tomato cage Gnome

Supply List:

- two – 9 foot long pine garland
- one tomato cage (33 inch) WILL HAVE TOMATO CAGE FOR SALE IF YOU LET ME KNOW
- AHEAD OF TIME.
- some 4 inch zip ties
- duck tape (Will only need a piece about 8 inches long)
- one nude knee hi
- a good hand full of stuffing for nose
 - a piece of long nap white fur at least 12 x15
 - a piece of red felt or fleece for hat (24 x 24)
- a large jingle bell for hat
- a winter pick for side of hat (decoration)
- about 10 good size plastic shopping bag (these can be used shopping bags)
- Wire cutters – to cut garland

Will need to sew hat together but will use one of the store machine.
