Supply List:

Embroidery Machine with a 5"x7" hoop or larger
Power Cord
USB stick (I will load design)
Thread
Pre-wound Bobbins
Stabilizer – Battilizer
Stabilizer – Hoopshape (for the trick or treat bag)

Candy Corn Table Runner

Stabilizer – Battilizer – 13 pieces to fit hoop
Fabric 1– Background ½ yd (8-7 ½" x 7 ½", 12 -2 ¾" x 3")
Fabric 2 - Bottom of Candy Corn ¼ yd. (2-3"x3", 8-4½"x4¼", 12-2 ¾"x 3")
Fabric 3 – Middle of Candy Corn ¼ yd (8-3"x4", 8-3"x4 ½", 12-2 ¾"x3")
Fabric 4 – Top of Candy Corn ¼ yd. (2-3"x3", 8-3 ½"x4 ¼", 12-2 ¾"x3")
Lining Fabric – ¾ yd for back and binding

31 Pillow 2 sizes 12" or 9"

Supply List is given for larger.

Stabilizer – Battilizer – 5 pieces enough to fix hoop
Background fabric – ½ yd.
Fabric 1 – 1/3 yd. (1- 9 ½" x 9 ½")
Fabric 2 – 1/6 yd. (4 – 4 ¼" x 4 ¼")
Fabric 3 – 1/6 yd. (4 – 4 ¼" x 4 ¼")
Fabric 4 – 1/8 yd. (1 – 4 ½" x 7 ¼", 1-3 ½"x 7 ¼")
Backing Fabric ½ yd.
Notions – fiberfill

Candy Corn Trick or Treat Bag

Suggested to use tear away stabilizer – I prefer to use a light weight cut away – 9 pieces to fit in hoop

Embroidery Supplies

Embroidery Machine
Power Cord
Hoops – 5x7
User Manual
Pre-wound Bobbins
Scissors
Pins/Wonder Clips
Extra Needles

Hoopshape – 9 pieces

Fabric 1 Bottom of Candy Corn $\frac{1}{4}$ yd.

Fabric 2 Middle of Candy Corn $\frac{1}{6}$ yd.

Fabric 3 Top of Candy Corn $\frac{1}{8}$ yd.

Fabric 4 Applique $\frac{1}{8}$ yd.

Lining Fabric – $\frac{1}{3}$ yd.

2 pieces of ribbon – $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 35"

Before Class:

Gather supplies and bring to class – no need to precut pieces but will save time
