Fabrics: Color A = Blocks and Border = 2 yards
Color B = Blocks = $\frac{1}{2}$ yard
Background=Blocks, setting triangles and corners = $1 \frac{1}{4}$ yards
Sashing, Inner Border and Binding = $1 \frac{1}{2}$ yards
Cornerstones = $\frac{1}{8}$ yard

Be sure there is enough contrast between fabrics.

Supplies:

Rotary Cutter and Mat, 6 x 12 ruler and or 6 x 24 ruler, squaring ruler optional.


Sewing Machine with $\frac{1}{4}$ inch foot, bobbins, 50 wt thread for piecing

Basic sewing kit- seam ripper, pins, marking tools

6 inch Drunkards Path Template, available at Pins & Needles on the first day of class.

Small 3 ring binder to hold Student Guide

Class will start and end promptly—please be set up and ready to begin class on time.
